During this week pupils will be taking part in workshops based around anti-bullying through a variety of drama groups and theatre companies who will be visiting our school.

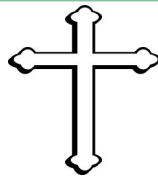
All pupils are invited to wear **odd socks** to school on **Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> November**.
