Pupil Acceptable Use Agreement for younger pupils in KS1

School Policy

Digital technologies have become integral to the lives of children and young people, both within schools and outside school. These technologies are powerful tools, which open up new opportunities for everyone. These technologies can stimulate discussion, promote creativity and stimulate awareness of context to promote effective learning. Young people should have an entitlement to safe internet access at all times.

This Acceptable Use Agreement is intended to ensure:

- that pupils will be responsible users and stay safe while using the internet and other digital technologies for educational, personal and recreational use.
- that school systems and users are protected from accidental or deliberate misuse that could put the security of the systems and will have good access to digital technologies to enhance their learning and will, in return, expect the pupils to agree to be responsible users.

 - ✓ I only open activities that an adult has told or allowed me to use.
 - ✓ I know that I must tell an adult if I see something on a screen that upsets me, or I am unsure of.
 - ✓ I keep my passwords safe and will never use someone else's.
 - ✓ I know personal information such as my address and birthday should never be shared online.
 - ✓ I know I must never communicate with strangers online.
 - ✓ I am always polite when I post to our blogs, use our email and other communication tools.
