

Dear Parents/Carers of children in our school,

<u>Please keep this booklet with you or take a photo on your phone so when</u> <u>shopping you can keep all the necessary information to hand.</u>

Please consult the information below before buying school uniform to ensure that all children have the correct clothing <u>and footwear</u> when they return to school in September. We know that you will support us in this so that we can maximise your children's potential. We want to ensure that all our pupils are well-presented and ready to learn when they are in school. Thank you for your continued support.

Footwear - NO EXPENSIVE BRANDS

Pupils are required to wear sensible black shoes or plain black trainer style shoes (no coloured logo) as their outdoor shoes. Please ensure that these shoes are appropriate, not slip-ons, high heels or open-toed shoes.

Children should not wear shoes with laces unless they are able to tie them independently.

In bad weather, children may wear wellingtons/boots but they should bring a pair of shoes/pumps to school to change into. If your child comes to school in wellingtons in bad weather, could you please provide a "named peg" to keep them together.

Please could you regularly check the condition of your child's pumps to make sure they still fit and that the soles are intact with adequate grip and that the Velcro still sticks.

Please be aware it <u>is not</u> essential to have uniform with logo but all clothing **must be labelled with your child's name,** including coats, pumps and hats. Please check regularly that your writing of names has not faded following washing.

We stress the need to label your child's uniform as we are working hard to reduce the amount of lost property across the school and to prevent

additional costs to parents. A lost item of clothing is difficult to locate when not labelled.

Hair Styles

Hair styles should be neat and tidy. Children should not come to school with hairstyles that are attention seeking for example hair gel, beaded hair styles, closely shaved hair /shaved patterns including tram lines and patterns or unnatural colours etc.

We ask that all long hair is tied back with suitable hair accessories. This is essential for PE and recommended throughout the school day. This policy is followed to minimise the risk of injury and to avoid the spread of head lice.

Jewellery etc.

In the interests of health and safety, **the wearing of jewellery in school is NOT ALLOWED.** The exception to this is that children with pierced ears may wear simple stud earrings if they are able to remove and replace these without assistance for PE.
