Please consult the information below before buying school uniform to ensure that all pupils have the correct clothing <u>and footwear</u>.

A school uniform creates a common identity amongst all pupils but in <u>Ine with</u> <u>DFE guidance all branded items are optional other than book bags and</u> <u>swimming kit bags.</u> Therefore, our school uniform can be purchased from any retailer.

All items must be clearly labelled

Please check that all items of clothing all clothing are labelled with your child's name, including coats, pumps and hats. Please check regularly that names have not faded following washing. We stress the need to label your child's uniform so as to reduce the amount of lost property across the school and to prevent additional costs to parents. A lost item of clothing is difficult to locate when not labelled.

P.E. Uniform

It is important for pupils to wear a PE kit for PE lessons. As pupils wear PE kit on the days when their class have PE, it is important that they wear the correct PE uniform.



Please could you regularly check the condition of your child's pumps to make sure they still fit and that the soles are intact with adequate grip and that the Velcro still sticks.

Footwear - Please avoid expensive brands

Pupils are required to wear sensible black shoes or plain black trainer style shoes (no coloured logo) as their outdoor shoes. Please ensure that these shoes are appropriate ie. not slip-ons, high heels or open-toed shoes.

Children should not wear shoes with laces unless they are able to tie them independently.



In bad weather, children may wear wellingtons/boots but need to also bring a pair of shoes or pumps to change into. If your child comes to school in wellingtons/boots in bad weather, could you please provide a "named peg" to keep them together.

Hair Styles

Hair styles should be neat and tidy. Children should not come to school with hairstyles that are attention seeking for example hair gel, beaded hair styles, closely shaved hair /shaved patterns including tram lines and patterns or unnatural colours etc. Long hair should be tied back with suitable hair accessories. This is essential for PE and recommended throughout the school day. This policy is followed to minimise the risk of injury and to avoid the spread of head lice.

Jewellery etc.

In the interests of health and safety, **the wearing of jewellery in school is NOT ALLOWED.** If children have pierced ears, only small stud type earrings are acceptable. These should be removed for PE/swimming; if your child can not remove their own earrings, please make sure they do not wear them on PE/swimming days.

Also please note no make-up, no nail polish, no false nails- gels or otherwise, no false eyelashes, no tattoos or transfers.
