Maths Week

This week the children have been participating in a variety of activities and lessons for Maths Week. On Tuesday and Wednesday this week we were visited by Brainwave Education who explored 2D and 3D shapes with every class. The children made their own 3D shapes out of sticks and balls, and to see how many people they could fit in a 1 by 1 metre cube. Each class also looked at the book 'One is a Snail, Ten is a Crab' and carried out various maths activities in relation to it, including counting, adding, subtracting, multiplication, percentages and even a bit of algebra! Throughout the week the children also saw how Maths relates to other subjects across the curriculum, such as Geography, Art and Music. We hope the children enjoyed the week and thank Mrs Giles for all her hard work organising this week's events.
