Community Green Space Grants

The Mayor of London, Sadiq Khan, has awarded £1.1 million to community projects across the capital to help them improve and create new local green spaces. After unprecedented demand from local groups, Mr Khan has provided almost three times his original budget for this first year of the Community Green Space Grants, with 55 projects across 23 boroughs receiving between £5,000 and £50,000 through his Greener City Fund. The Mayor's funding will be matched by an additional £2.8 million from the projects themselves, as well as other public, private and charitable funders.

We are pleased to announce that Corpus Christi has been one of the beneficiaries of this fund and has been granted £20,000 to support the planting of a green wall(s) at Corpus Christi. On behalf of the whole school community we would like to thank a group of parents; Kathryn Eade, Nadya Morgenstern, Landa Acevedo -Scott and Bernie Butler, who have been instrumental in securing the funding for this project which will of benefit to the whole school community. More information on this will be provided in the coming weeks when details have been finalised.

Parenting styles
