## From The Headteachers

#### **Sports Day**

This year Sports Day will be held on **Friday July 6<sup>th</sup>**. It will be held at the same location as last year on grounds owned by Dulwich College.

Access to the grounds can be gained from College Road, in the area opposite the main part of Dulwich College. All children will need to be at the grounds by 9.00am. Children in Nursery and Reception will be released by their class teachers at 10.30am after they have competed in the flat races. Parents and carers of children in early years are welcome to either stay in the grounds with their child to watch siblings, or leave the venue at this time. Children in Year 1 to Year 6 will need to be collected from the grounds at 1.00pm.

The children need to wear their Corpus Christi P.E. kit (navy shorts and blue polo or white t-shirt with the C.C. logo) and trainers. In the case of inclement weather the children should also wear their school jumper or P.E. sweatshirt, a rain coat and tracksuit bottoms (only if they have these) over their shorts and t-shirts. Nursery children should wear their nursery uniform with trainers. Sun hats will be provided when the children arrive at the grounds and we will provide sun cream on the day, however it would helpful if you could apply some before children arrived. All children will be provided with a piece of fruit during the day, but they will need to bring a named water bottle with them.

As always, parents and family members are warmly invited to come and support their children throughout the morning. We will however have designated areas for adults which we would ask you to keep within, so as to not impede on the children's participation.


