Year 4 had a wonderful time at Dulwich College on Tuesday, bringing their learning about Sir Ernest Shackleton to life and seeing the James Caird lifeboat.

Dulwich College is home to the James Caird, a 23-foot lifeboat in which Sir Ernest Shackleton (1887-90) sailed 800 miles through Antarctic seas to get help for his stranded crew. Each year, 1,400 primary school children and hundreds of adults visit to learn about this extraordinary journey.

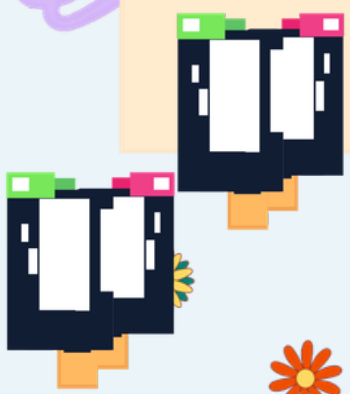
