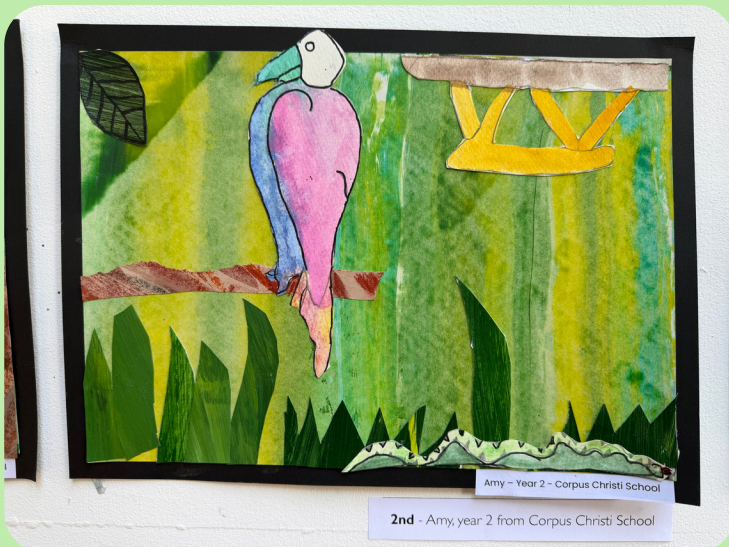


Outstanding balances

The 2026 Summer Reading Adventure is starting on 20th July. Pop into your local library to pick up your reading adventure pack, borrow books and collect stickers and prizes.

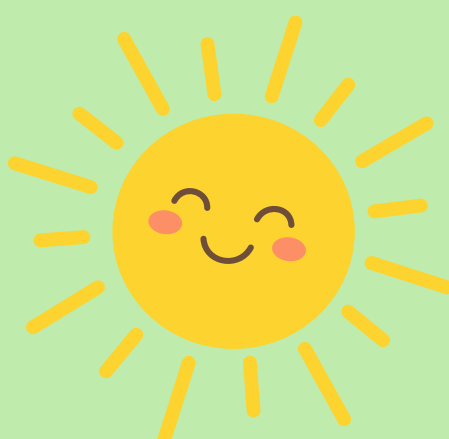
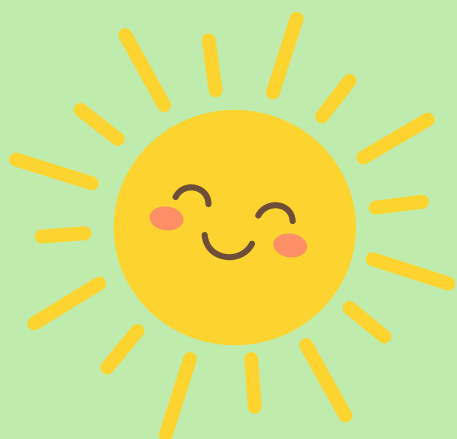
