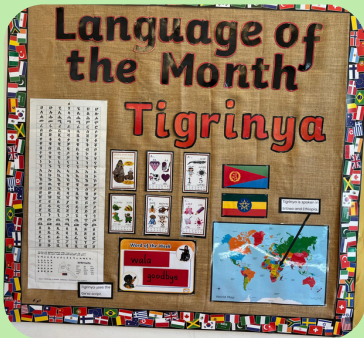
Music Charges

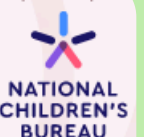
