



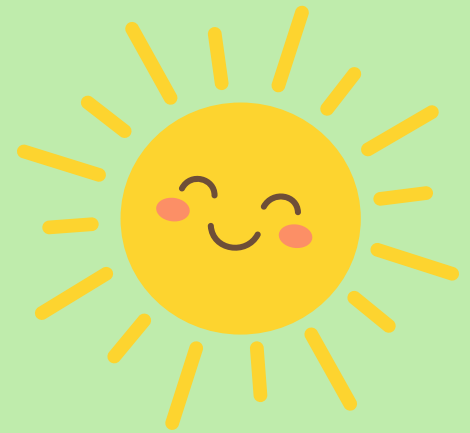
Marian Procession

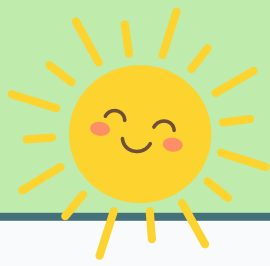
Saturday Football

Magazine Cup final will be Saturday 13th June against Rosendale School.

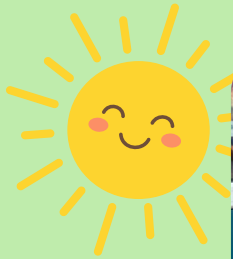




FAREWELL
