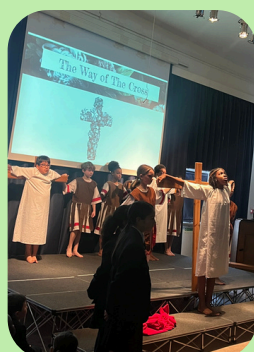


**Way of the Cross**
