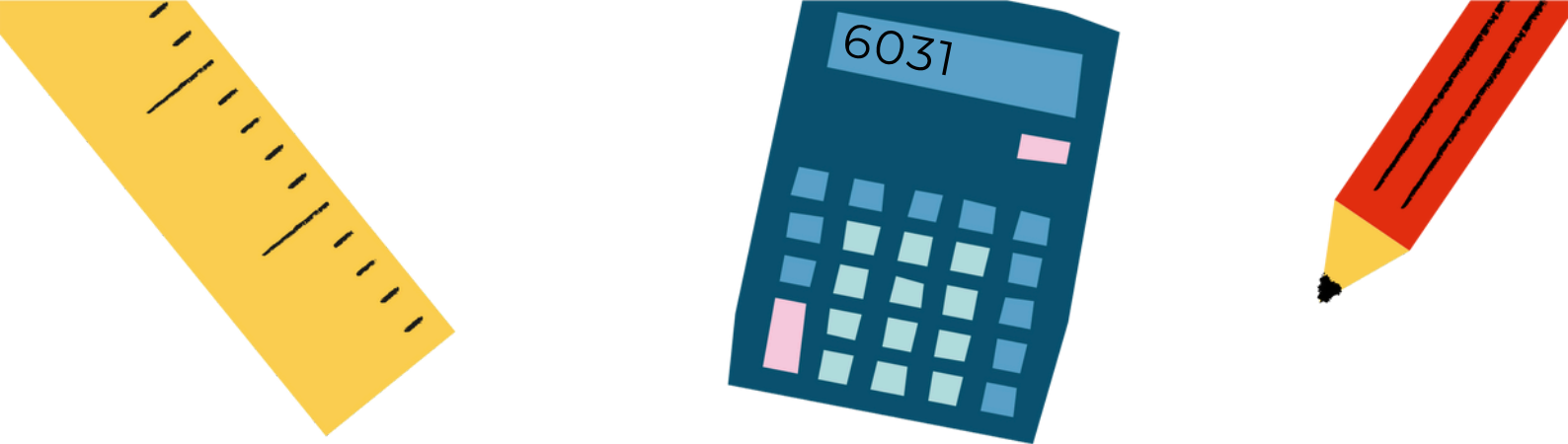
NSPCC Number Day
