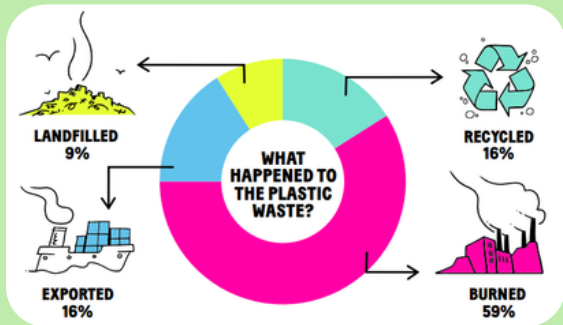


The Big Plastic Count

The Year 2 Green Team would like to say a huge 'THANK YOU' to you all for supporting The Big Plastic Count this year, the results are in and the response was overwhelming. Across the UK, we counted over 1.5million pieces of plastic. The Big Plastic Count has revealed that only 16% of our plastic waste is actually recycled. The majority (59%) is burned in the UK, and the rest is sent overseas (16%) or to landfill (9%). Fruit and veg packaging was the most common type of plastic, accounting for 16%. Plastic packaging on uncut fruit and vegetables is unnecessary and unpopular. Many items already have their own natural protection, yet are still sold wrapped in plastic that is thrown away almost immediately.

Summer Term 1 Music charges are now available to pay on your ParentPay account. Thank you to all who have paid so promptly.

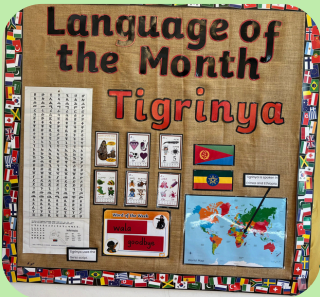
First Strings Experience - Royal Academy of Music

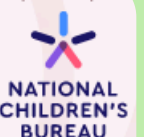
