School Mass - Epiphany

On Tuesday children from Year 1 - Year 6 attended Mass at Corpus Christi Church for the start of the new term and to celebrate the Epiphany when the Three Kings visited baby Jesus to bring Him special gifts. The Mass was led by Fr. Godfrey and we thank our Year 6 children for preparing the Mass.

Attendance and Punctuality

We would like to remind parents the importance of good attendance and punctuality and remind parents that requests for leave need to be made in writing prior to the date of the leave and before you make any travel arrangements. Lambeth's Educational Welfare Officer is working closely with all school's to ensure that good practice is followed regarding school absences and they do have access to our attendance data and monitor the procedures we have in place when a child is missing education. They visit the school every month and we will highlight any concerns we have in regards to attendance and punctuality.

At assemblies next week we will be presenting 100% attendance badges to the children from Reception to Year 6 who have been in school each day during the Autumn Term.

Monday Clubs will commence next **Monday 12th January for 5 weeks ending on Monday 9th February.**


Monday Cooking Club due to start 12th January has been moved to Wednesday 25th March.



