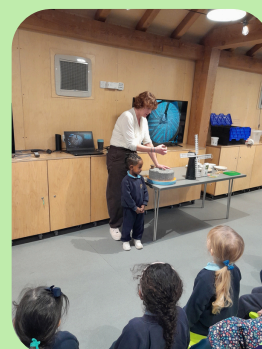
Holocaust Memorial Day

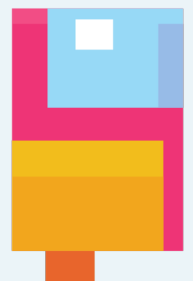
