They are also completing their final rehearsals for the annual school Carol Service which will be shared with parents next week.

Christmas Dinner and Christmas Jumper Day

Next Thursday is Christmas Dinner and Christmas Jumper Day. We ask all children to make a minimum donation of £1 to support the Ace of Clubs in Clapham. Ace of clubs is a family-like charity providing transformative support for those who are homeless, vulnerable, and otherwise marginalised. Their centre on St Alphonsus Road provides for the immediate needs of those in desperate circumstances with safe shelter, food, warmth, clothing, laundry and showers. Presently they are helping between 80 and 100 people per day. The number of people coming to the centre for help has more than doubled over the last 18 months due to a severe increase in homelessness since the beginning of the pandemic. Anything extra you can donate will be gratefully received.

Outstanding Balances

Please ensure that your Parentpay account is up to date and all charges for Autumn Term 2021 are clear. Registration for the Spring Term activity clubs was released earlier this week and applications will be sorted next week. Please note we will be unable to consider any application for an activity if your Parentpay account has a negative balance, as of Monday 13th December, on any service your child accesses at school, e.g. dinner money, music lessons, Breakfast or After School Care Clubs, deposits for residential trips.

Reception Application September 2022

If your child was born between 01/09/2017 and 31/08/2018 your child should be starting primary school in September 2022. Nursery parents need to apply online through your home borough for your child's primary school place. This is known as a Common Application Form. Please ensure you complete this by **midnight Saturday 15th January 2022**. If you apply after this date the likelihood of gaining a place at your preferred school may be significantly reduced therefore, apply online and apply on time.
