Mental Health Week

This week has been children's mental health week. Teachers have shared lessons, games and resources from The Place2Be with the children in lesson time. The Juniors also had an Equity, Diversity and Inclusion assembly, where the focus was on speaking out to help others who may be unhappy or feeling isolated and left out. The children were also introduced to the Worry Box, which is by the Co-headteachers' office. Children can write anything that is worrying them on the slip and a teacher will follow it up with them. The Safe Space was also highlighted as somewhere to talk when children have worries. Teachers will also put resources in their weekly email for families at home.

We know that it can be daunting for parents and carers to navigate the online world with their children. There are so many apps to keep up with and many online harms they may not be aware of. This week was Safer Internet Week to mark the occasion, Lambeth are offering parents free webinars to help you keep your child safe from online harms. Parents can sign up to either [15 March 11-12](#) or [March 22 5-6pm](#).

The course is for those who want to gain knowledge about the online world and how to keep children and young people safe.

During the course they will cover:

- Different social media platforms, gaming platforms, and message boards frequently used by young people
- How to safeguard your children through web controls
- Conversation starters to prompt your children to talk about their online experiences
- Useful resources you can use and how to get further support

Those attending will also get access to further free training on how to safeguard your child from online radicalisation delivered by Prevent.
