# From the Headteachers

#### **Curriculum Information**

Next Friday Phase Group Leaders will send out information to parents relating to the children's curriculum for each year group. This will include important dates for the term.

#### **Punctuality**

Presently, there is a ten-minute arrival window at the beginning of the school day at Corpus Christi which is from 8.45am to 8.55am. Pupils arriving after 8.55am need to be signed in at the school office. A child is late if they arrive after the school bell has sounded at 8.55am and will be marked as such. Pupils arriving after 09.05am will be marked as "unauthorised late" which is counted as an absence. We ask that you co-operate with school staff on duty at the school gates and support the school's policy on punctuality. Any queries about lateness should not be taken up with staff on gate duty but with the office team or headteachers.

#### <u>Uniform</u>

We wrote to parents last week about the school's expectations in relation to uniform. Despite this there has been a few issues this week with children forgetting pieces of uniform and a small number of children who have had to be reminded that their hair needs cutting. The school uniform, worn by all children, is an important and distinctive feature of the school. We place an emphasis on achieving high standards of dress and appearance because we believe it encourages the children to take pride in themselves and their school. We ask parents to ensure that their children always wear all parts of the uniform daily - this includes blazers, caps, and boaters. Girls should keep long hair tied back, and boys' hair should be above the collar and the ears and not have any dramatic changes in length i.e. it should blend from shorter to longer without any dramatic changes in length or lines of demarcation. Hair styles should be neat and discreet. Jewellery is limited to watches and plain gold or silver stud earrings. We thank all parents for complying with our uniform policy.

#### Jubilee Bank Holiday

As you may already be aware next year there will be an additional Bank Holiday to celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. As this date falls within the summer half term holiday already set, Lambeth School's will need to reduce the teaching year by one day elsewhere in the school calendar. Consequently, the school will now be closed to all pupils on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2021.

#### Free School Meal Eligibility
