Achievement

Corpus Christi School was included in this year's The Sunday Times list of the top 250 State Primary Schools recently. Attached to the email is a letter from Dr Simon Hughes the Director of Education for the Diocesan Education Commission. It is a great testament to Catholic Education that 10 of the schools from the Southwark Diocese were included within this list. The Primary League Tables were also released recently which ranked schools according to the percentage of children achieving the expected standard in reading, writing and maths at the end of KS2. Corpus Christi School is ranked top school in Lambeth and we would like to take this opportunity to thank children, staff and families in relation to both these achievements.
