### Eat them to Defeat them Campaign 21

During this half term, we will be taking part in the 'Eat them to Defeat them' campaign to encourage children to eat more vegetables. Since the campaign debuted in January 2019, it has led to sales of over 517 million additional children's portions of vegetables worth £63m. The campaign is set to reach 5.2 million households with children, thanks to donated media from ITV, Channel 4, and Sky, as part of their £10 million commitment to promoting healthy lifestyles for children and encouraging them to be more enthusiastic about eating vegetables.

Today children from Reception to Year 6 will bring home an activity pack with lots of fun games and puzzles, and more information about the campaign. We will also be discussing the importance of making healthy choices in school too. Each week we will focus on a different vegetable.

### Summer Uniform
