Last Friday the School Council Wider Impact Team met with us as they were concerned about the impact of the war in Urkraine. They asked if as a school we could organise a collection to support the work of the Red Cross and Red Crescent who are very concerned by the intensification of fighting in Ukraine, which threatens to bring essential services to a halt, create huge upheaval, loss of life, and separate families. Anything you can donate will help charities to provide healthcare, emotional support and essentials like food and fuel to the people of Urkraine. Donations can be made by logging onto your ParentPay account, and we thank all our families who have donated so far, your generous response this week has been overwhelming, thank you again.
