Secondary School Transfer

Year 6 parents need to apply online through your home borough for your child's secondary school place. Please ensure you complete this by midnight Thursday 31st October 2019.

Nursery parents need to apply online through your home borough for your child's Reception Class place 2020. The application process is now open and closes on Tuesday 15th January 2020.

Winter Uniform

All Reception and Year 1 children must ONLY wear the school navy winter coat. This was introduced as an item of school uniform in September 2018 for Reception children. Children from Year 2 - Year 6 can continue to wear their own plain navy blue school coat. If you are purchasing a new coat you may wish to consider the school's one.
