Many children have to walk long distances to school, and we would like to help them. If you are not going to fit into your school shoes in September, and they are still in good condition, please consider donating them to the children of Mozambique. On the last day of term, children can come to school wearing their own sensible shoes or trainers, and drop their school shoes into the bag in the office. Please make sure the shoes are relatively clean and do not have holes in the soles. School uniform should still be worn, this is a mufti day for feet only.
