"We were making this film that really had a truly independent spirit, it had a truly independent methodology. When we were filming, we always thought the film was imbued with the spirit of a teenage girl and it is just phenomenal that it has come here and that the spirit of a teenage girl has won best film, with a completely different way of filmmaking, with all these incredible women." 
