Remembrance Service

This Thursday in classrooms across the school we held a two-minute silence to 'Remember Together' the service and sacrifice of the men and women of Britain, the Commonwealth and the allied nations who fought together in two World Wars and those who have lost their lives in subsequent conflicts. Mrs Duffy, our RE coordinator, and the School Chaplains led a service which included the Last Post and La Reveille to signify the beginning and end of the silence. Our chaplain representatives from every class laid wreaths in the school hall. We would like to thank Mrs Duffy for helping to organise our service. This event is part of our British Values programme which aims to help the children grow into safe, caring, democratic, responsible and tolerant adults who can make a difference to British society.

Kindness has always been one of our school's core values and underpins all our interactions.
