Next week is Walk to School Week! We encourage as many children as possible to walk or find a sustainable and healthy way to travel to school. According to Living Streets, a generation ago, 70% of children walked to school, and now it is less than half. By walking (or cycling and scooting), your child can be well on their way to reaching their minimum requirement of 60 minutes of activity per day, before they even make it into school! We understand that this is not possible for all children (for example those who live far away), but we encourage your child to take part by walking as much of the school journey as possible for them. We will be undertaking travel surveys throughout the week and look forward to hearing how many of the children walked to school!
