#### Remembrance Day

The school observed Remembrance Day with a virtual assembly led by the head boys, girls and school chaplains and Mrs Duffy. Photographs are on the school Gallery page of the website. This event is part of our British Values programme which aims to help our children grow into safe, caring, democratic, responsible, and tolerant adults who can make a difference to British society in the future.

Pupils and staff paid their respects when arranging their poppies in honour of members of the Armed Forces who have and continue to serve in the line of duty and then paid tribute with a one minute of silence and reflection.

Class wreaths have now been placed on the class altars with a prayer of dedication. Children are also being invited to write a prayer into their class prayer books throughout the month of November.

### Anti-Bullying Week

Anti-Bullying Week is running from Monday 16<sup>th</sup> – Friday 20<sup>th</sup> November. It is a week which highlights the importance of people accepting differences and uniqueness and the importance of standing up against any form of bullying.

The children will be attending online assemblies and in class activities and discussions. This year the official organisers of Anti-Bullying Week is the charity The Anti-Bullying Alliance. This charity was set up by the NSPCC and The National Children's Bureau. The theme is United Against Bullying marked by Odd Socks Day on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> November.

Your child can come to school on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> November wearing any type of odd socks to raise awareness against bullying of any form. The charity's main areas of work are: supporting learning and sharing best practice through membership; raising awareness of bullying through Anti-Bullying Week and other coordinated, shared campaigns; delivering programme work at a national and local level to help stop bullying and bring lasting change to children's lives.

#### **Primary School Transfer**

If your child was born between 01/09/2016 and 31/08/2017 your child should be starting primary school in September 2021. Nursery parents need to apply online through your home borough for your child's primary school place. This is known as a common application form. Please ensure you complete this by midnight Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2021. If you apply after this date the likelihood of gaining a place at your preferred school may be significantly reduced therefore, apply online and apply on time.
