There is a bar and shared buffet that evening, so please bring along some 'finger food'.

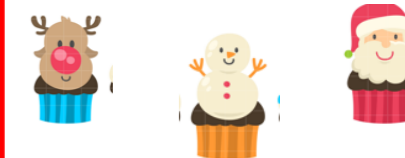
