#### Harvest Festival

Tuesday 18th October is Harvest Festival, and the children will have a celebration in the school hall to mark the event. We will be supporting the Ace of Clubs in Clapham which is a family-like community providing transformative support for those who are homeless, vulnerable, and otherwise marginalised in our area. Their centre on St Alphonsus Road provides for the immediate needs of those in desperate circumstances with safe shelter, food, warmth, clothing, laundry, and showers. Ace of Clubs is a place where those who are alone can find acceptance, a sense of belonging and renewed purpose to see their lives restored. Presently they are helping between 80 and 100 people per day. The number of people coming to the centre for help has more than doubled over the last year due to the recession, job losses and a severe increase in homelessness. Today you will receive a letter detailing more information about this important school event.
