Remembrance

This week on Monday 11th November we held a two minutes silence in the main hall at 11am to 'Remember Together' the service and sacrifice of the men and women of Britain, the Commonwealth and the allied nations who fought together in two World Wars and also those who have lost their lives in subsequent conflicts. A group of junior children played the Last Post and La Reveille to signify the beginning and end of the silence. Our chaplains helped representatives from every class to lay wreaths. We would like to thank Michael Burke, a school foundation governor, for attending the service and Philip and Vivienne Powell who shared with the children at assembly their thoughts on the effect war had on everyday people in Lambeth. Thanks also to Mrs Duffy our RE coordinator for helping to organise our service. This event is part of our British Values programme which aims to help the children grow into safe, caring, democratic, responsible and tolerant adults who can make a difference to British society.

Anti-Bullying Week

The school has had a successful Anti-bullying week where we have all learnt about how to keep one another safe from bullying. We have learnt about this year's theme of how "Change Starts With Us" and that as an organisation it is everybody's responsibility to tackle bullying. In class the children have worked with our mood meters to realise the impact of bullying and how to help victims.
