### Parking

Unfortunately this week there have been a numerous instances of Corpus Christi parents parking in Horsford Road on the yellow zig-zag 'school keep clear' lines. Invariably this is done by parents who have left it to the last minute to drop off their children and on finding nowhere to park decide that the 'school keep clear' lines are the next best option. **The yellow zig zag lines must not be parked on!** Doing so demonstrates a lack of consideration to the safety of other Corpus Christi children and parents, as well as having a detrimental effect on the traffic flow on the street as cars find it difficult to pass. Also please **avoid doing '3 points turns' in the road** as this can be a danger to children at an already busy time. It is much safer to all if you drive around the block. **The traffic warning signs that are placed on the road should also not be moved.** They are there to ensure that the children can see the road clearly and cross safely.

Coming to school in the morning in plenty of time would go a long way to alleviate parking problems. You might even consider parking further away from school to reduce congestion and walk instead.
