Music Charges Summer Term 2

Charges for the final half term of music lessons are now available to pay on your Parentpay account.

From September 2022 the charge for music lessons will increase to £82.50 per 6 lessons. The cost of music tutors provided by Lambeth Music Services has increased and whist Corpus Christi School highly subsidised these lessons it is unfortunate that there must be an increase to parents.

A reminder that if your child will not continue with lessons in September, or at any other time during their contract, 6 weeks written notice is required.

Extended Daycare from September 2022

Today we released the survey to complete if you would like to apply for an extended daycare place from September 2022, breakfast and after school care clubs. All existing contracts will cease at the end of July and existing users will need to apply through the survey. We will not consider any applications if there is an outstanding balance on any service your child accesses at school, this includes dinner money, educational trips music lessons, exam fees and existing extended daycare accounts. The survey will close on Friday 1st July, and we will notify you soon after this date if you have secured a place from September.
