Scooters and Bicycles

We are pleased that so many children use scooters and bicycles when journeying to and from school. However, Trent Road in particular becomes very congested at the beginning and end of the day and this has proven an issue for some of our local residents when using the road at the same time. We have already spoken to the children about keeping themselves safe and watching the speed in which they travel on their scooters, being careful of roads and other pedestrians. We now ask that children dismount at the corner shop and do not travel on their scooters or bicycles on the payement of Trent Road, as this compounds the problem when congested at busy times. We also ask if children could use other roads, such as Lambert and Horsford Road, to ease the congestion on Trent Road. We thank you for any help with this matter.
