Covid Restrictions

Earlier this week the Prime Minister announced that most Covid restrictions in the UK are staying in place for the moment, because of concerns over the Delta variant. The government had hoped to 'remove all limits of social contact' in England on 21st June. That has now been set back to 19th July. Sadly, this will mean that end of year school events will have to take place without parents and has also resulted in changes to arrangements for some residential trips. It is also important to remember quarantine rules and the governments traffic light system, when planning any summer holidays outside the UK.

The school will not provide remote learning provision for any children who are not able to attend school in September because of quarantine rules relating to summer holidays.

Windrush 2021

In the wake of the Windrush Scandal the government announced an annual Windrush Day to take place on 22 June. This year the Local Authority has put together a programme to celebrate and commemorate the contributions made by the Windrush Generation to the social, economic, and religious life in Britain since the Second World War. The theme this year is I am Here.

In 2019 and 2020 Corpus Christi celebrated the Anniversary of the Windrush with assemblies attended by Cllr Sonia Winifred which demonstrated the children's understanding of the journey of Windrush.

Last year Lambeth residents were asked to come out on their doorsteps at 10:27 am on 22nd June and play Lambeth's unique version of the Jimmy Cliff song 'You Can Get It'. Colourful Radio broadcast the countdown to the song and ITV covered it live on This Morning. Cllr Winifred and her neighbours broadcast the song live to This Morning's 900,000 + viewers. This year they are going to do it again but with an outdoor sing-along with some Year 4 and 5 children in the Corpus Christi playground.
