### Covid 19

As more and more workplaces and secondary schools are providing lateral flow tests for students and staff, there will be more instances resulting in positive results. This will help to limit transmission in school if the test is confirmed positive. It is also helpful that you communicate with the school so that we are aware of your situation at the earliest opportunity. Over the weekend this can be done by emailing the school office or Mrs Connery and Mr Coyle directly so that track and trace procedures can take place.
