

NHS Track and Trace

To support the NHS Test and Trace process, Public Health England has agreed a 6-day window after the final day of teaching in which schools are asked to remain contactable so they can assist with contact tracing.

The guidance is as follows:

Up to and including Wednesday 7th April, if your child tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, then we will need to be contacted to identify close contacts and advise self-isolation, as they may have been infectious whilst in school.

If your child tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, **the school does not need to be contacted**. You should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

After Wednesday 7th April, you are asked to follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

If you need to contact the school, we will need to know your contact details, the date in which symptoms first appeared and/or the date in which the test was taken. This information will assist us when identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation.
