Music Charges Summer Term 2

Charges for the final half term of music lessons are now available to pay on your Parentpay account.

From September 2022 the charge for music lessons will increase to £82.50 per 6 lessons. The cost of music tutors provided by Lambeth Music Services has increased and whilst Corpus Christi School highly subsidises these lessons it is unfortunate that there must be an increase to parents.

A reminder that if your child will not continue with lessons in September, or at any other time during their contract, 6 weeks written notice is required.

The Year 3 students are approaching the end of their MX Band lessons. Next year the students will have the opportunity to continue the same instruments, or to choose another one, by having one-to-one lessons with Lambeth Music Service tutors. Most of the instruments that they have been learning on this year are specially adapted for the MX project.

One-on-one lessons will be on regular instruments and information about this and the cost has been given to the children today. If your child would like to continue with their learning, please complete the reply slip and you can either return it to your child's class teacher or the School Office.
