Responsibilities:

Year 5 children will be given a Year 2 buddy.

They will also have the opportunity to become school librarians for the year.

Year 6 children will have a variety of opportunities to encourage responsibility throughout the school. They will become school monitors and assist in daily duties.

Uniform:

- Corpus Christi Backpacks may be purchased from the School Office.
- Parents are asked to ensure that the children always wear the correct school uniform.
- Please make sure all uniform is **clearly labelled** with your child's name.
- Shoes: all children must wear sensible black shoes, ideally with a child-friendly fastening. Boots and footwear with flashing lights are not allowed.
- Jewellery: the only item of jewellery that children are permitted to wear are plain gold stud earrings.
- Hats, blazers, ties, pullovers and summer uniform must be purchased from the school office. Other items may be purchased from chain stores.
- Hair: girls should not wear lots of decoration in their hair other than plain hair band or slides.
- Hair extensions may not be worn in school.
- Boys should have a sensible hair cut. Long hair, steps, lines or shaved patterns are not allowed.
- Year 6 children do not have to wear their school caps or hats.

P.E. Kits:

- A Corpus Christi white t-shirt or blue polo shirt (Yrs 5 & 6 only)
- Navy blue shorts
- Plain black plimsolls
- Children may have trainers **in addition to** plimsolls for games.
- A Corpus Christi PE bag

Please remember that all items of PE kit should be **clearly named**.

PE Kits should be brought to school on a Monday and will come home on a Friday.

Welcome to Year 5 & 6

Equipment:

The children are expected to have a pencil case with a range of stationery to work with at school and at home. Fountain pens with blue ink are required, please ensure your child's pen is labelled with their name.

Homework:

Children in Year 5 & 6 use homework diaries, this incorporates their weekly spelling lists and reading record. Homework is given out on a Monday. Maths homework is due in on a Tuesday and English is due in on a Thursday. Spellings are issued on a Friday and tested the following Friday.



Curriculum:

During the Autumn term, Year 5 will be studying Victorian Britain, learning about the Geography of the British Empire at this time, Queen Victoria, and many different aspects of life for people living in the Victoria Era. Year 6 will study Africa in the first half of the term, as part of a geographical study, and in the second half of the Autumn term they will focus on the life of William Shakespeare and his impact on the English language. This year all classes will continue studying French as a Modern Foreign Language in addition to the usual curriculum.

Year 6 SATs:

All Year 6 children are required to take end of Key Stage 2 assessments during the Summer term. A comprehensive programme of Booster Classes will begin from **Thursday 31st October 2019** from 3:30pm - 4:30pm and will carry on every Thursday until May 2020. The SATs will be administered during the week beginning **Monday 11th May 2020**.

Extra Curricular Activities:

In the Upper Juniors your child will have the opportunity to join a variety of after school clubs. These clubs have been confirmed already and more information is to follow.

Children who are part of the World Famous Corpus Christi Band have rehearsals on Wednesdays from 2:30-3:30pm. Year 5 & 6 will join the band rehearsals from Wednesday 9th October 2019.

Year 6 School Journey to PGL

Year 6 children will visit the PGL activity centre in the Isle of Wight from Monday 18th May until Friday 22nd May 2020.

Year 5 Bosco Camp

Year 5 children will have the opportunity to camp at the St. John Bosco Centre located in Colchester from Monday 8th June until Friday 12th June 2020.



Mobile phones:

We recognise that mobile phones are a part of everyday life for many pupils. At Corpus Christi, we discourage pupils from bringing mobile phones to school for a number of reasons. In exceptional circumstances, we ask that parents discuss the issue with their child's class teacher. The pupil will then need to switch off and hand in their mobile phone to their class teacher at the start of school day and remember to ask for its return at the end of the day.
