Was your child born between 01/09/07 and 31/08/08?

If yes, your child should be starting secondary school in September 2019. If you are a Lambeth resident, you should apply for a school place using the safe, free and easy to use portal via our website, lambeth.gov.uk/eadmissions

It's available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, up until the admissions closing date, which is midnight **Wednesday 31 October 2018**. If you apply after this date the likelihood of gaining a place at your preferred school may be significantly reduced.
