Free School Meals

As you are aware you do not pay for children's lunches in school. We want to ensure that parents can access all the support that is available to them. Children with Free School Meal (FSM) eligibility also get access to reductions on the cost of school journeys, some music tuition and total concession on the Educational Trip contribution. The school also access additional funding to ensure that those children are not disadvantaged in any way. School Census Day is the 3rd of October, any children confirmed as eligible by that date will ensure additional funding for the school.
