## Long Service and New Arrivals

Today, we had a presentation for Mr Kelleher and Mrs Smart who have now taught at Corpus Christi for twenty years. This is a great achievement for them personally and shows the dedication they have to the children and families of our school. We can now look forward to many more years' service and thank them for everything they have done for the children in their care. ### School Improvement Plan (SIP)

As a school community we have decided on three main school priorities for our school to work towards achieving for the next three years. Post Covid, school closure and remote learning, we reflected on what we were forced to lose, what we wanted to bring back and how we would recover the lost time and opportunities of day-to-day school. In July 2021, the School Evaluation Form was completed in line with the new Ofsted Framework. In August 2021, SLT, the school governors and MLT discussed and finalised the following three main priorities for the school moving forward:

- SIP Priority One: Reading, Phonics and Spelling
- SIP Priority Two: Diversity & Inclusion
- SIP Priority Three: Curriculum Enrichment & Pupil Leadership

The new SIP will be available to view on the school website very soon.

### **Covid Updates**

Yesterday, the Prime Minister announced that all Plan B measures will be removed in England, with a full return to Plan A by Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> January. This decision comes in response to national infection data showing the prevalence of COVID-19 to be on a downward trajectory. Whilst there are some groups where cases are likely to continue rising, it is likely that the Omicron wave has now peaked nationally. There remains significant pressure on the NHS, but hospital admissions have stabilised, and the number of patients in Intensive Care Units (ICU) remain low and are falling. If this continues to be the case, we are planning to invite parents back into school for assemblies. <u>Click here</u> for all assembly dates for this term.
