World Earth Day

This week the children have learned about "World Earth Day". Classes have worked on how to look after our planet and follow the school's Eco Code. We hope that the children at Corpus Christi will all become great advocates for our planet as part of their role of being good citizens. As part of this, we also wanted to share with you that we have just renewed our energy contract and whilst we looked at several energy suppliers one stood out for us because of their green credentials and ethics.
