# DATES TO REMEMBER

### Absence

Since September 2013, Headteachers in England have no longer had the discretion to approve absences of up to 10 days a year for family holidays in "special circumstances". Unfortunately in the last six months we have had a small number of Corpus Christi parents who have taken their children out of school 'on holiday' without the school's prior permission. On each occasion these absences took place on either end of a school holiday and were unauthorised. Children's attendance at school is something which is very important and regular absence can lead to a detrimental effect on a child's future attainment. Any leave of absence granted by the Headteachers will need to be supported by documentation. Please note any absences which are authorised by the Headteachers are still classified as absences and will affect your child's attendance percentage during the year. Permission cannot be granted if the documentation shows bookings have been made prior to a leave of absence request. Should a child be absent for 20 consecutive days for any reason other than an exceptional circumstance, the child will be taken off roll and reported as missing from education to Lambeth Council's attendance team. Please refer to the school's Attendance & Punctuality Policy and diary and term dates on the school's website before making any holiday arrangements.
