### **Music Charges Summer Term 2**

Charges for the final half term of music lessons are now available to pay on your Parentpay account.

From September 2022 the charge for music lessons will increase to £82.50 per 6 lessons. The cost of music tutors provided by Lambeth Music Services has increased and whilst Corpus Christi School highly subsidies these lessons it is unfortunate that there must be an increase to parents.

A reminder that if your child will not continue with lessons in September, or at any other time during their contract, 6 weeks written notice is required.
