Choir

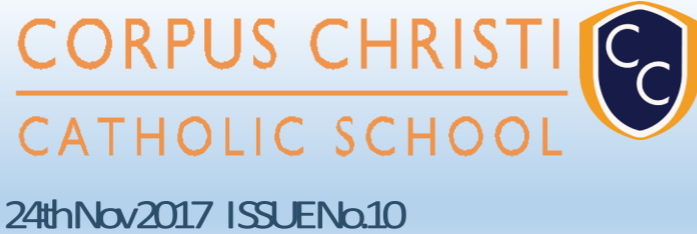

Activities for Children

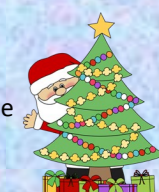
