Polio is a serious infection which can cause permanent paralysis. The virus has been found in London, so children aged 1 to 9 years are being encouraged to have a polo vaccination for their protection, and we want to make sure that families in Lambeth have good access to vaccination clinics.

<u>Uniforms</u>

Thank you for ensuring children are wearing their uniforms correctly. There have been a few issues which we are speaking to children about but would rather not make them feel worried.
