### **Attendance**

This week 167 children from Reception to Year 6 received their 100% attendance badge for the Spring Term, 45% of the children in school, this is a wonderful achievement. We are aware that some children's regular hospital and medical appointments are made during school day and sickness is unavoidable. Children who have not achieved 100% attendance because of these situations will still be recognised for their excellent attendance at the end of the year. Also, it is important that children do not take holidays during term time. Always check our school term dates and plan holidays outside of these dates.

## **GymRun**

At Corpus Christi, we care deeply about the impact of improved physical health on children's PE experiences, their whole school learning and on their overall health and well-being. We strongly encourage children to develop their physical health by running, walking, cycling, scooting and climbing to develop upper body strength as much as possible.

The Gymrun Curriculum combines differentiated bodyweight exercises and short periods of running. Children work in pairs to complete seven movements in 20-25-minutes. The teaching focus is on quality of movement and on maximising the time all children spend moving. The aim of Gymrun is for every child to reach five key outcomes in PE by the age of eleven:

To move quickly and accurately, engage their core muscles, support their bodyweight, squat and jump effectively and jog for five minutes without stopping. We introduced Gymrun to the whole juniors last year and have just completed this year's assessments. The order of difficulty of the badges is as follows: Red (first stage), Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue, Navy, Purple, Pink (highest stage). We congratulate our Head Boy, Heath Dover, on achieving our first pink award. The children have the option to purchase their Gymrun badges at a reduced cost of £1 from next week. They will need to be sewn onto their PE kits.

## **Football**

Year 4, 5 & 6 boys took part in a friendly football match at St Stephen's in Vauxhall, their behaviour and performance were excellent, well-done boys on today's achievements. We intend to organise some more friendly matches this term including a girl's football tournament.
