Anti-Idling

A short video entitled “The Invisible made Visible” highlights the dangers to children’s health from idling near schools. This video was published by St George Breathing Better, a local action group fighting for improved air quality in our area and city wide, with a focus on air pollution caused by traffic.

The Green Team over many years, in conjunction with Lambeth’s Sustainability Team and many of our parents, have highlighted this issue. We will be measuring our pollution levels again, as we apply to become a ‘School Street’. Problems with pollution are particularly acute at busy times of the day when children are being picked up and dropped off at school. Let us continue to work hard together to keep down pollution levels for our children and each other.
