Platinum Jubilee

On 6th February this year Her Majesty **the** Queen became the first British Monarch to celebrate a Platinum Jubilee, marking 70 years of service to the people of the United Kingdom, the Realms and the Commonwealth. To celebrate this unprecedented anniversary, events and initiatives will be taking place with a four-day UK bank holiday weekend from Thursday 2nd to Sunday 5th June, during half term.

The four days of celebrations will include public events and community activities, as well as national moments of reflection on The Queen's 70 years of service.
